

TC.13 2002 REPORT to IFIP Council

Bled, Slovenia, 6 - 7 March 2002

This report notes only changes that are known as of 22nd February, 2002. Additional information will come from the IFIP TC13 meeting being held in Prague, Czech Republic, 28 February to 2 March, 2002. There has been no other TC13 meeting since the last report to IFIP TA.GA in Natal, Brazil, 2002.

2002 REPORT TO THE COUNCIL

1. Meetings Held and Scheduled

The 20th TC.13 meeting is being held in Prague, Czech Republic on 28 February to 2 March, 2002. This will be the first TC.13 meeting chaired by John Karat (US-ACM). The main agenda item for the meeting will be the selection of the host location for **INTERACT 2005**.

2. TC.13 Membership and Officers

Dr. John Karat (US-ACM) assumed the position of Chair of TC.13 in September, 2001 following the GA meeting in Natal.

TC.13 membership stands at 30 of the full IFIP Member Societies. Dr. Gilbert Cockton has replaced Brian Shackel as the representative from the UK, and Cecilia Baranauskas has replaced Clarisse Sieckenius de Souza as the representative from Brazil. Dr. Peter Gorny (Germany) has retired, and we await notification of a member to replace him by the GA member society for Germany.

The first term of Prof. Dr. Matthias Rauterberg as Chair of WG13.1 expired, and the working group has elected him to a second term (2002-2004).

The term of WG13.3 Chairman, Goeff Busby, expired and elections held by the working group. The group has nominated and elected Prof. Monique Noirhomme-Fraiture as Chair for 2002-2004.

The first term of Prof. Chris Johnson as Chair of WG 13.5 will expire this year, and the working group will hold elections at their next business meeting in the summer of 2002.
